TGO is connecting Narromine pipeline to Tomingley supply dam on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2017.</li> <li>• Review of VPA form is to be completed by prior to next round of funding opening in January.</li> <li>• TGO has not commissioned a report into mobile phone reception. A trial was carried out using Optus, however it was found the service was as poor as Telstra.</li> <li>• JH called Sean Buxton and wish hill well on behalf of the CCC.</li> </ul>	MW

<p><b>Operations update provided by MW:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Noise, Dust, Blasting – No exceedances were recorded.</li> <li>• All mining activities are complete on WRE2, rehab works remain to be completed and these will be carried out on day shift only.</li> <li>• There will be no further dumping of waste on WRE3 during night shift. Some more waste will be placed at the northern end, however this will only occur for a 2 week period on day shift intermittently.</li> <li>• Rehabilitation update – works are focused on WRE 2 dome and topsoil spreading, WRE3 push down and drop structures. Committee generally commented on how noticeable progress was.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Community Information and feedback:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Underground exploration drilling program has been finalised. Results being reviewed and decision on underground will be made 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2018.</li> <li>• MW circulated current complaints register. 1 complaint was received from Peak Hill regarding dust. Complainant was advised that it is not possible that the mine was causing dust issues in Peak Hill.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>General Business:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• JC advised that Narromine Shire Council was in the process of reviewing the operation of all committees of Council, Tomingley Advancement Group being 1 of those committees. The Advancement Group will now only meet 2 times per year.</li> </ul>
