The cause appeared to be as a result of mine noise being noticeable as a result of the Newell Highway being closed due to Forbes floods. Infringement Notice issued by Department of Planning. • Rehabilitation update – works delays continue due to the wet weather. • Update was provided on Caloma 2 works and presentation on drainage.
