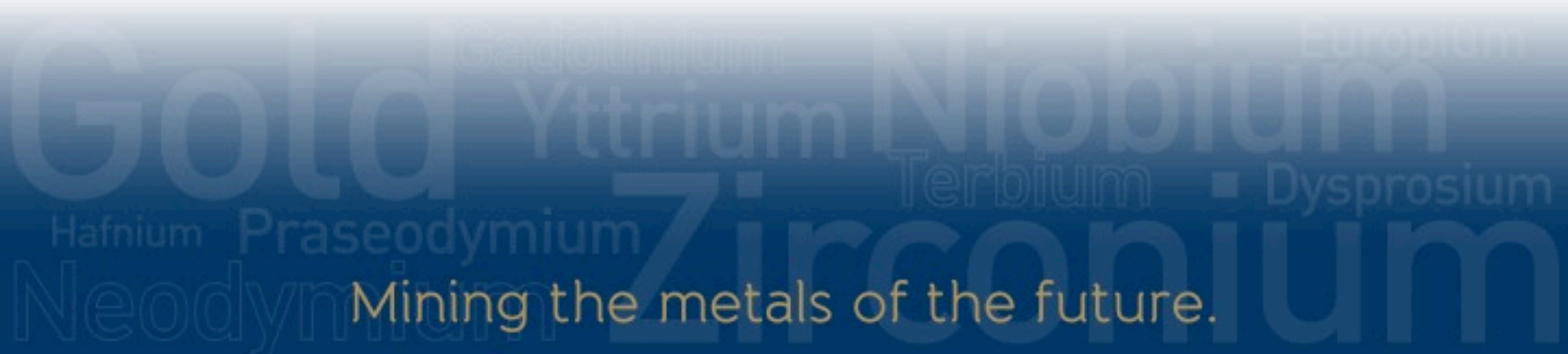

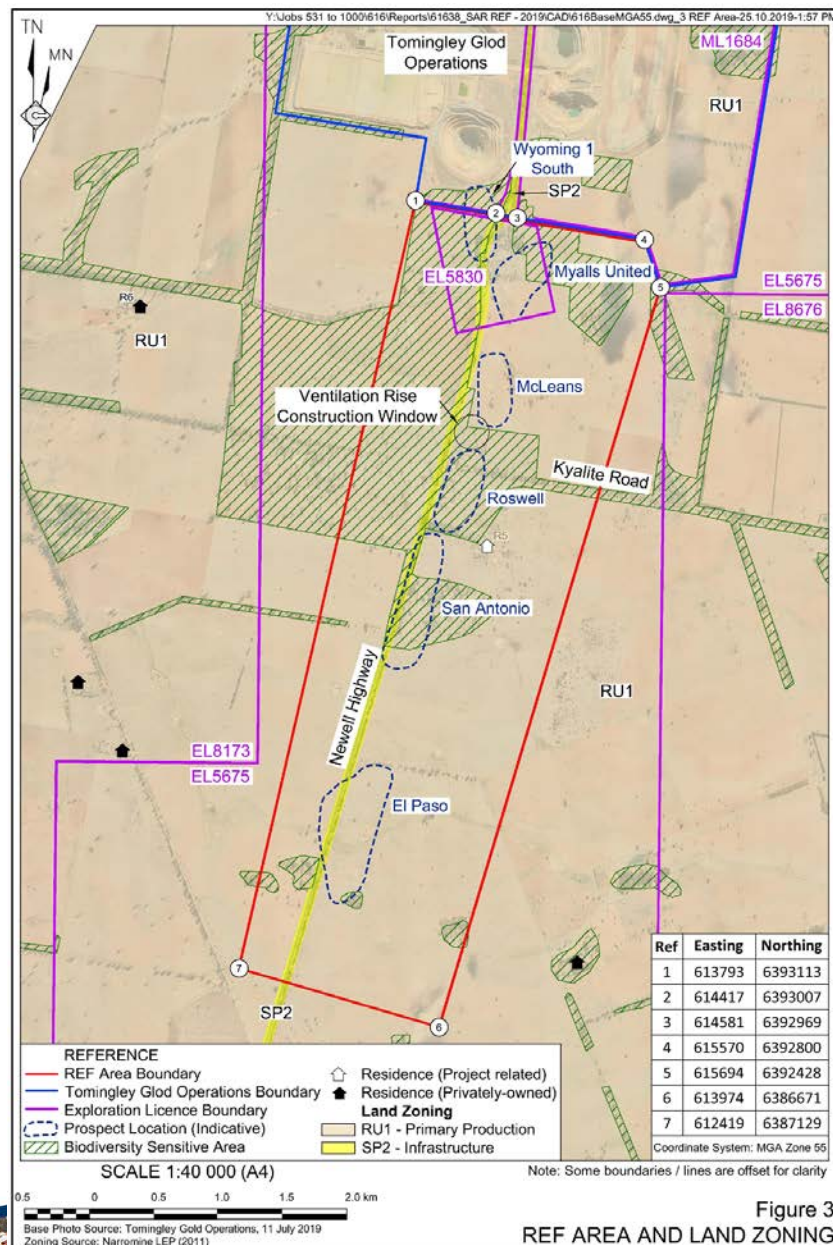
Extending the life of TGO

- Gold Corridor Between Tomingley and Peak hill (Roswell, San Antonio and El Paso)
- 60,000 m drilling program
- Results from 18,208 so far
- Results extremely encouraging suggesting potential for Mine development
- First inferred resource models
 - Roswell - Mid December
 - San Antonio - February



Underground exploration drive – seeking approval

- Seeking Regulator Approval to develop U/G exploration drive.
- South from WY1 Decline towards Roswell and San Antonio prospects
- Exploration that can not be done from the surface
- Minimal Community impact
 - Ventilation rise north of Kyalite Rd
 - TGO Negotiating purchase of this land
- TGO Resource Definition Project (exploration and Resource Definition drilling) expected to take 9 months.
- If feasible –
 - Application to DPIE
 - Environmental studies (EIS)
 - Landowner discussions
 - Approvals and Licencing for U/G and Open Pit development

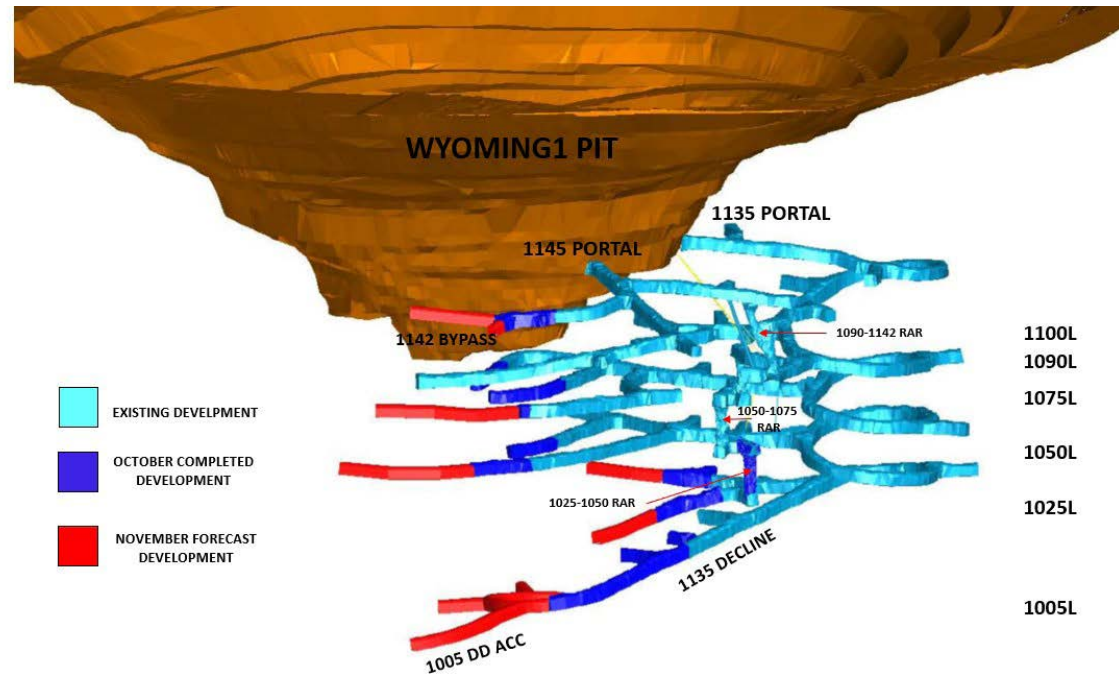

Underground Update

- Started Development 10/1/19
- Total Development to Date – 2601m (End of Sep)
- Average of 312m/mth since Feb.
- Achieved 356m of development in September.
- Passed three levels of ore so far and a small amount of ore has been extracted and processed
- Drilling continues additional ore identified – possible mine life extension
- Purchased additional Jumbo, a third Bogger and Truck
- Additional persons employed to operate the new equipment



Underground Update

- Started Development
10/1/19



Processing Plant

- Low grade stockpile processing
- U/G ore processed to confirm our grade.
- Shut down from mid December
- Planned Maintenance
- Build-up U/G stockpiles
- Shutdown for 2-3 months
- Resumes production on a campaign basis
